

FORD ATTITUDE FAQs

Q: WILL INSTALLING THE FORD JUICE VOID MY FACTORY WARRANTY?

A:

While the answer is straightforward from a legal standpoint, we also want to educate our customers (and after-market consumers) on some industry realities and offer some common sense precautions to minimize your risk.

Consumers of aftermarket products are protected by The Federal Magnusson-Moss Warranty Act. The Act states that if something breaks on your car and you take it in for warranty repair, the dealer must honor your warranty unless they can prove that whatever modifications you have added to your car actually caused the problem.

While as a consumer you have strong legal protection regarding your vehicle's warranty, there is also a practical reality that different automotive manufacturers and dealers have greatly varying views on aftermarket products, in particular those that produce horsepower, such as performance enhancement chips, modified intake manifolds, or aftermarket exhaust systems. There are dealers and manufacturers out there that will use the presence of a horsepower upgrade to void your vehicle's warranty. They will do this regardless of whose product you are using. Any aftermarket company that does not acknowledge this is misleading you.

The bottom line is that while the law protects the consumer and provides for enforcement of the warranty, it is very difficult for most people to hire an attorney and fight a voided warranty. Edge recommends that you **always disconnect and/or remove any performance device or programmer before you take your vehicle to a dealer for any service**, in order not to interfere with Diagnostic equipment.

Q: DOES THE ATTITUDE INCREASE POWER?

A:

While the Attitude monitor itself doesn't produce the power, the addition of the Attitude to the Juice module provides 2 additional levels of adjustable power. These power levels produce rear wheel power gains of 40, 60, 80, 100 and 115 horsepower and 80, 100, 160, 250 and 290 foot pounds of torque.

Q: WILL I NEED ADDITIONAL GAUGES?

A:

No, with the addition of the Attitude controller, there will no longer be a need for gauges. With the backlit display screen, Exhaust Gas Temperature temperatures and boost readings are displayed for easy and clear reading either digitally or as a bar graph.

Q: HOW MANY VARIABLES DOES THE ATTITUDE TRACK AT A TIME?

A:

The Attitude can display up to 4 variables at a time digitally or you can choose 2 different variables at a time to be displayed as a bar graph.

Q: WHAT DOES THE ATTITUDE MONITOR DO?

A:

The Attitude allows you to

- Access 5 different power levels
- Change power levels on the fly
- Display EGT and Boost
- Automatically de-fuel to control EGT
- Display RPM
- Low boost fueling adjustment
- Disable EGT backdown for specified time
- Store and display max values
- Set audible alert settings

Q: WHAT IF MY ATTITUDE IS NOT READING BOOST?

A: If your Attitude is not reading boost it could be a problem with the brown map wire. First check the connections and make sure there is no bare wire. If this all looks normal call Edge.

Q: WILL THE ATTITUDE WORK WITHOUT THE EGT PROBE INSTALLED?

A: Yes the Attitude will work however it will not display and EGT temperature and will not have back down.
