

Step 1.

Have you called for your Custom Vehicle Mounting Kit?*

*In most cases the Custom Mounting Brackets are included in the price of your plow and you will need to order them separately from SnowBear as they are specific to your vehicle model (if you are not sure, please contact us and we can help).

You will find your Mount Certificate inside the plow box.

Hint

You will be asked for the Certificate Number which is located on the Mount Certificate.

Although the Mounting Brackets are specific to your vehicle model, the Vehicle Mounting Cross Member is included with your plow at the time of purchase. This Cross Member is universal and will fit any SnowBear Vehicle Mounting Bracket.

Step 2.

Plow Assembly

Please refer to the easy-to-follow instructions in the owner's manual when assembling your plow. The parts list and diagrams will guide you through the assembly and installations with ease.

Installing the scraper is the first step towards completing your plow assembly.



Hint

Plow assembly is easier and faster if you have a second person to help.



Shown above are the first steps in assembling the plow hardware. Here you can see the assembly of the winch frame to the upper A-frame and lower A-frame.



The final step will be to attach the SnowPlow markers to the plow.

Hint

If you have purchased a Snow Deflector Accessory, you will want to attach this before the markers.

Step 3.

Cart Assembly

Each plow includes a unique storage cart for easy installation on your vehicle between plowing and makes summer storage a breeze.



Hint

To adjust the cart have the plow attached to the vehicle and sitting on the cart.

Step 4.

Mount Attachment

When you receive your SnowBear Vehicle Mounting Kit you will need to install it with the Vehicle Cross Member



Mount Kit Brackets
(shown in red)

Vehicle Cross Member
(shown in yellow)

Hint

Loosely attach the Brackets and Cross Member to your vehicle's frame before you tighten any bolts or nuts.

Step 5.

Getting Connected

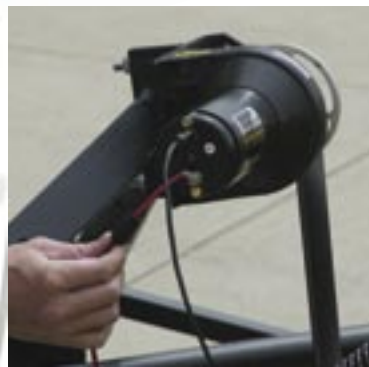
In order for your window mounted switch to be operational you will need to connect the wiring to the battery and the winch.

Follow the step by step instructions in your **Owners Manual**.



The quick connects are stored under the hood and inside the bumper of the vehicle ready to be connected whenever the snow falls.

The window mounted switch can be removed in seconds and stored for future use.



Hint

The easy-to-follow wiring instructions in your owner's manual will make set-up a snap!

Step 6.

Attaching the Plow

Now that the wiring is in place you are almost ready to plow. But first you must attach the plow to your vehicle. Using the storage cart, slide your plow onto the two pins of the mount.



Hint

For smoother on/off operation, grease the pins of the Vehicle Cross Member.



Insert and close the two hitch pins to secure the plow to your vehicle.

Plug the Quick Connect at the front of your vehicle to the plow's winch.

Place the window mounted switch in the driver side window and connect the two Quick Connectors under the hood.

Use the window mounted switch to lift the plow and remove the Cart and you are on your way!

Caution

Always make sure both hitch pins are attached through the Cross Member.



Features

Adjusting the angle of your plow is simple with the **manual release handle**. By pulling the handle towards you, the blade is free to move left or right.

Always ensure the blade is locked into position prior to plowing.

While plowing, the blade is designed with trip springs to tip forward if it is overloaded. It will automatically reset itself into the plowing position once you back away.



An emergency **manual handle** is included with your plow to lower or raise the blade in case of power failure.



A **safety hook** has been provided to allow for short transportation of the plow while on the vehicle. SnowBear does not recommend driving long distances with the plow installed on your vehicle.

Caution

Avoid driving on highways or at high speeds with the plow attached to your vehicle.

Caution

Always check the plowing area for obstacles that can cause damage to the blade or your vehicle.

Hint

Always plow as wide as possible during the first snowfalls to allow for snow buildup.

Night Vision

Off-Road Light Kit

For those days when it seems as though the sun never rises, the Off-Road Light Kit will give you that extra illumination to brighten your plow path. This kit simply bolts on to pre-existing holes on the plow and plugs into your vehicle's battery.



Reduce Snow Spray

Snow Deflector

When plowing in light or deep snow the rubber Snow Deflector keeps spray off the windshield. It bolts onto existing holes on the top of the blade.



Smooth Ride

Skid Shoes

Enhance your plow's performance over gravel, soft surfaces or uneven terrain with your choice of Heavy-Duty or Regular Duty Skid Shoes. The addition of Skid Shoes to your plow will also protect your plowing surface and reduce wear-&-tear on your scraper blade.
